BLOODHOUND AND DRAGHOUND RULES

MASTERS AND OWNERS ARE REQUESTED NOT TO MAKE ENTRIES IF IN THE SIX WEEKS PRIOR TO THE SHOW THEIR HOUNDS HAVE SUFFERED FROM THE COUGH OR OTHER DISEASES. IF HOUNDS DEVELOP THE COUGH AFTER THE SHOW, THEY MUST NOTIFY THEIR GOVERNING BODY IMMEDIATELY.

1. **Exhibiting packs will be entitled to 3 admittance tickets and 3 sets of vouchers for lunch which will be available for hunt staff in charge of hounds. Additional admittance tickets can be purchased in advance of the Show only**
2. All hounds must belong to packs of bloodhounds or draghounds registered with the MDBA.
3. Any entered draft hound must have hunted at least 1 season with the showing pack.
4. **You may show a hound not bred by your pack** but in such cases please prefix the hound's name with the name of the pack which bred the hound in question.
5. Hounds placed first and second in this year's show may go forward to the championship.
6. Everyone showing hounds in the ring must wear hunting dress, but assistants may wear white kennel coats and bowler hats.
7. It is recommended that slip-leads be used. Only dry biscuits will be allowed to be used by huntsmen showing hounds in the ring.
8. Welfare of exhibiting hounds. Exhibitors must not allow overcrowding in the kennels and must ensure that drinking water is always available.
9. Hounds showing clinical signs of infection or illness must not be brought to the Showground and will not be permitted to be shown. On arrival on the Showground if an exhibitor has any doubt or concern the Show Vets must be contacted immediately to examine the animal and the Vet's decision as to whether it is fit to remain on the Showground will be final.
10. **In bloodhound** single hound classes up to 3 hounds may be entered but only 2 of those hounds may be shown on the day. In bloodhound couple classes up to 2 couple of hounds may be entered but only 1 couple of hounds may be shown on the day.
11. **In draghound** single hound classes up to 6 entries can be made but only 4 may be shown on the day i.e., 4 hounds in all classes except 8 and 16 where 2 couples may be shown.

ALL KENNELS MUST BE VACATED IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING AFTERNOON JUDGING HAS FINISHED. NO HOUNDS MUST BE LEFT UNATTENDED AT ANYTIME DURING THE SHOW.

Hounds can be accommodated overnight in the showground; they must arrive by 7pm. In this circumstance prior permission must be agreed with Nigel Church
